Board Member Expectations

1. The Board of Directors for Delta County Fuller Center for Housing shall help determine the Mission and Goals of the organization. Therefore, a Board Member is responsible for determining the mission (why the organization exists) and the goals (what the organization will provide) of the organization. Board members should be aware of the current programs and services, as well as future needs that might require innovative programs and services.
2. The Board of Directors of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing shall ensure adequate resources exist, which shall include funds to support the services and programs. Therefore, a Board Member is responsible for the fiduciary responsibility of the organization, and as such, a Board Member shall be involved in fundraising and shall also be financially committed to the success of the organization; that is, a Board Member is expected to personally contribute funds to the organization annually, though the amount remains at the discretion of the individual member.
3. The Board of Directors of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing uses committees to accomplish tasks required for proper functioning of the organization. Therefore, it is expected that a Board Member will participate in at least one committee of the board and attend most meetings of the Board of Directors (see [bylaws](#)), which may result in about 10 hours of activity per month (including travel time).
4. The Board of Directors of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing shall provide financial oversight of the organization. A Board Member maintains this fiduciary responsibility, through overview of monthly reports by the treasurer and acceptance of those reports. Board members are expected to provide assistance to the Treasurer by assuring financial activity matches those funds budgeted for the activity. These activities include assuring Delta County Fuller Center for Housing meets all legal and tax obligations.
5. The Board of Directors of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing shall act within the limits of the law, and more importantly within the principles of dignity towards other human beings. Therefore, a Board Member shall operate within the regulations and laws of cities and counties in which the organization functions, including those regulations and laws of the State of Colorado and the federal government. Board Members shall also be familiar with the Bylaws of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing and shall operate within those confines.
6. The Board of Directors of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing shall engage in strategic planning that assures the accomplishment of both short-term and long-term goals, maintaining the viability of programs today and those needed in the future. Therefore, a Board Member shall be aware of and regularly evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of current programs and services. A Board Member therefore should be aware of the nature of the participants in the programs and services, and how participants may or may not be benefitting from the services provided.
7. The Board of Directors of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing shall recruit and orient additional Board Members on a regular basis, including assessment of board performance in terms of the Mission and Goals of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing. Thus, a Board Member should make an effort to assure representation from the cities or geographical areas serviced by the organization, including, when appropriate, representation from a current or

former homeowner aided by the organization. A Board Member shall regularly assess the needs of the board, in terms of providing services and make efforts to recruit those that would be beneficial to the mission and goals of the organization.

8. The Board of Directors of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing shall work to enhance the public awareness of Delta County Fuller Center for Housing. Therefore, Board Members shall be advocates for the organization and the services provided.
